# Know your rights.

# IF ICE AGENTS SHOW UP AT YOUR DOOR:

### **DON'T OPEN THE DOOR**

- Ask the agent to show a judicial warrant through the window or under the door and make sure it's a valid judicial warrant.
- A valid judicial warrant must have: your name, correct address, valid date, and must be signed by a judge.
- If the judicial warrant has incorrect information, the warrant is not valid.
- Show the agent this flyer by sliding it under the door, or holding it up to the window.

### **REMAIN SILENT**

- Do not answer any questions and say: "I wish to remain silent."
- If you speak after you invoke this right, you must say 'I wish to remain silent' again to protect your rights. Repeat this throughout your interaction.
- Do not give information about where you were born, nor when or how you arrived in the country.

### SPEAK WITH A LAWYER

 Say "I will call my attorney" and speak with your lawyer before answering any questions

### **DON'T SIGN ANYTHING**

• Do not sign any documents



ORDER FOR WARRANT FOR ENTRY ON PREMISES TO SEARCH FOR ALIENS WHO ARE IN THE UNITED STATES WITHOUT LEGAL

The United States of America, having filed an application to authorize officers of United States Immigration and Customs without legal authority and, if any such persons are found on the premises, to exercise their authority pursuant to section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1357, to question them to determine whether they are such aliens and, if there is probable cause to believe they are such aliens, to arrest them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that U.S. Immigration and Custome Enforcement shall conduct the entry and search during daylight hours with ten (10) days of the issuance of this warrant, and make its return to this Court with ten (10) days of the date the entry and search have been completed.

Must have correct name, address, date, and be signed by a judge.
